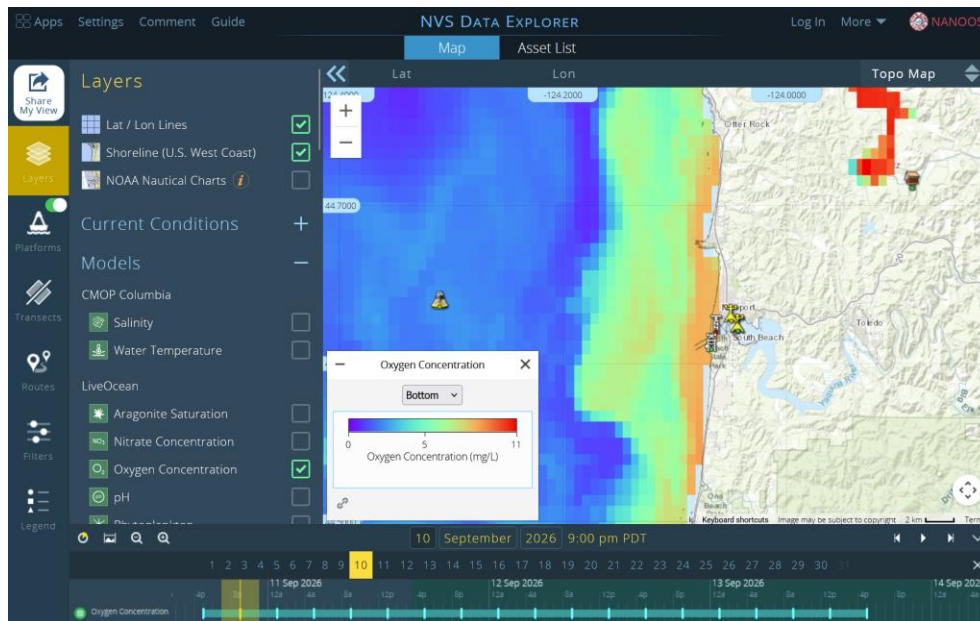


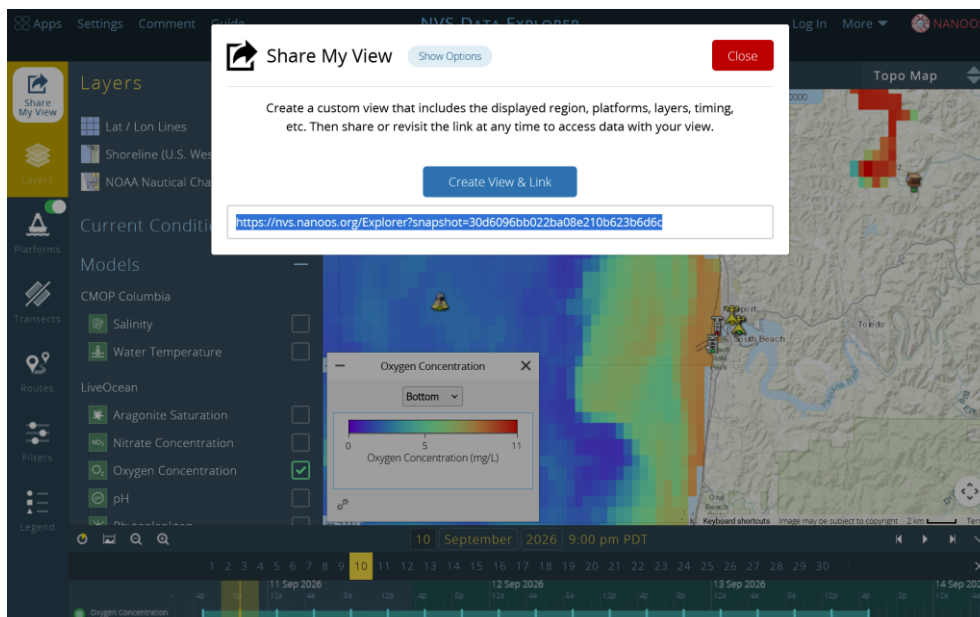
NVS Share My View

The NANOOS Share My View tool allows users to define or “customize” the information presented within NANOOS Visualization System (NVS) and create a unique link that can be shared with others to recreate the desired display.

To use this feature, set NVS to display the region of interest, the assets (individual buoys, gages, and climate stations), and/or model overlay, etc. that you are interested in. For example, LiveOcean bottom oxygen off the coast of Newport, OR, is shown below.



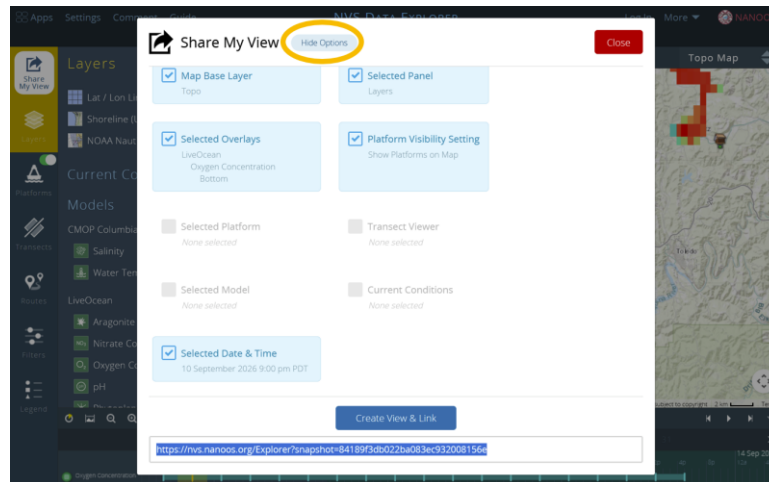
Then select the "Share My View" icon at the top of the menu on the left.



Hit the blue button “Create & View Link” to generate a unique URL. Copy the link provided to share with others or save it for yourself. Clicking that link anytime will re-create this view, updating it to the latest time available.

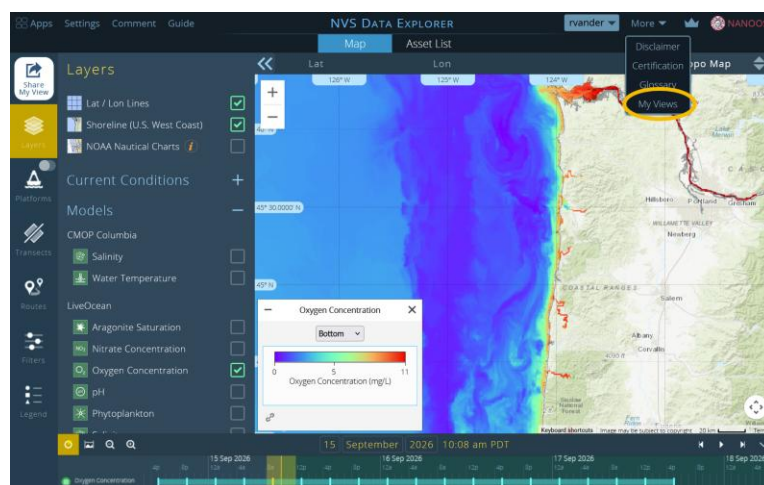
If you want to customize the view further, select “Show Options” for more details. The blue checkmarks indicate what will be displayed, which you can further customize by selecting or deselecting items.

The Share My View link will display the most current data unless you scroll down and add a check mark next to “Selected Date and Time” to preserve a specific event that you see.



When finished, select Create View & Link. You can then share or visit this link at any time to access data with these specifications.

If you have a NANOOS user account, log in to save your Views. While the link will work without being logged in, you can store unlimited Views for handy reference. When you log in to your NANOOS user account, open “My Views” in the drop-down menu under “More”.
